## The Search

We said in our January prayer letter that we believe God is leading us to move from our current rented offices. Two primary factors play into this decision.

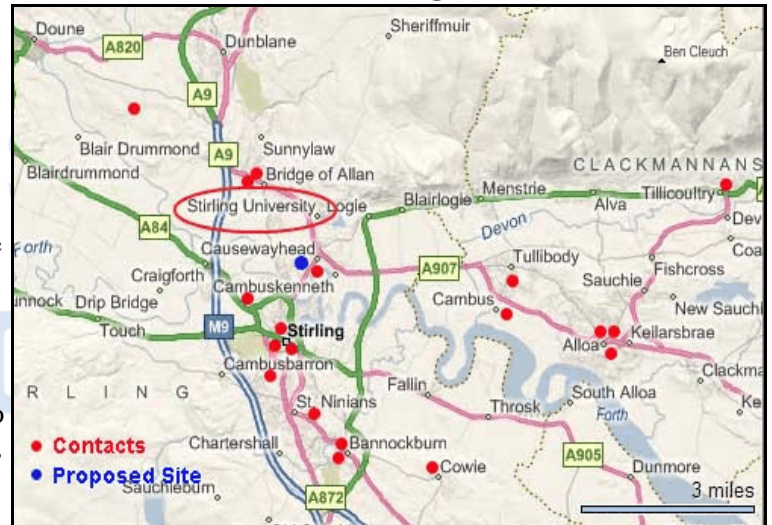
One is the current economic conditions. At the **current exchange rate** the US dollar is worth 30 percent more in Britain than it was just 6 months ago. *Now is the time to try to buy property rather than to continue to rent.*

Another is to consolidate our activities to a common, more **central location** site. We need a facility to serve as our *headquarters*, a building in which we can conduct *worship*, lead *Bible studies*, host *outreach* activities, have *offices* for the missionaries, to eventually house a *Bible institute*, and anything else that would be needful to strengthen the converts and churches resulting from this ministry.

## The Answer?

The house we are looking at has 8 sizable rooms (in addition to the bathrooms and kitchen), giving us plenty of space for *various meetings and Bible studies, offices, and worship*. There is also plenty of *parking*, which is always a major consideration in Stirling. It is in a locale that is *central* to most of the people to whom we are reaching out in the Stirling area, and, as an added bonus, the University of Stirling is only about a mile away. Finally, as do many British buildings, the property has a name. It is *"The Haven"*. We couldn't have come up with a better
