- Carrying the fan in the left hand in front of the face: "I am jealous of your acquaintance."
- Displaying the closed fan across the forehead: "You have changed."
- Twirling the closed fan in the left hand: "We are being watched."
- Twirling the closed fan in the right hand: "I love myself."
- Twirling the closed fan in the left hand: "Come and talk to me."
- Pressing the fan close: "Do you love me?"
